

- 2. The Body of Christ: an Organism not an Organization
- 3. Bx: "Spring of Living Water flowing from the heart..."
  - · Means?
  - Jesus equates Holy Spirit with Living Water
- 4. Common Misconceptions about Holy Spirit:



- I. Living Water has a S\_\_\_\_\_\_!
  - A. Jesus: 5 times references Himself
  - B. Ramifications of Christ being the originator and dispenser
    - 1. When you receive Christ: you receive the Holy Spirit
