- A. v3 God reveals the Unknown

- B. v2 Ezekiel see the Unpleasant

II. Face a Bad Situation (Ponder the I_____ble)

- A. v3 God's provocative Question
 - Is 59, Jer 32, Lk 1, Mt 19, Phil 4 "possible"!
- B. The 'God Factor'

III. Become part of the Solution (Proclaim the S_____le)

- A. Repeated specific commands to Preach!
- B. God's mysterious & miraculous use of preaching.
 - Is 55, Jer 23, Ro10, I Cor 1, Heb 4
 - II Tim 4:2
- C. Then, God does something: pours out His Holy Spirit!!!
 - Gen 3, Jn 2
