Our Sunday School classes offer an opportunity to grow in faith together by learning and applying God’s Word to our life. Classes meet at 10:45 am. Below is a description of each class and basic location of meeting space. Signs are posted at each class location. We hope you will join us!

Children’s Classes Preschool-5th grade

These classes meet downstairs in the Grand Hall area. They use the [Orange Curriculum](#).

Youth Classes

These groups meet upstairs on the floor above the sanctuary. They use the Orange Curriculum and Bible Studies from RightNow Media.

Middle School (grades 6th-8th)

High School (grades 9th-12th)

Taught by Trey Hedrick.

Koinonia Class

Meets on the second floor of the educational wing.
Teachers rotate throughout the year using Bible based curriculum resources.
Adults desiring deeper knowledge and relationship with the Lord.

Christians in Action (CIA) Class

Taught by Kevin Firquin
Meets in the lower level of the educational wing..
This class is a mixture of age groups and marital position. The class is currently studying Paul’s prison letters. They will then move to a study of the Resurrection. The focus will include the historical account of the Resurrection and expand on what it actually means in our faith. As it is the central event of Christianity, the study will look into how the Resurrection shapes and dominates our faith and the concept of the Kingdom of God.

The Young at Heart Class

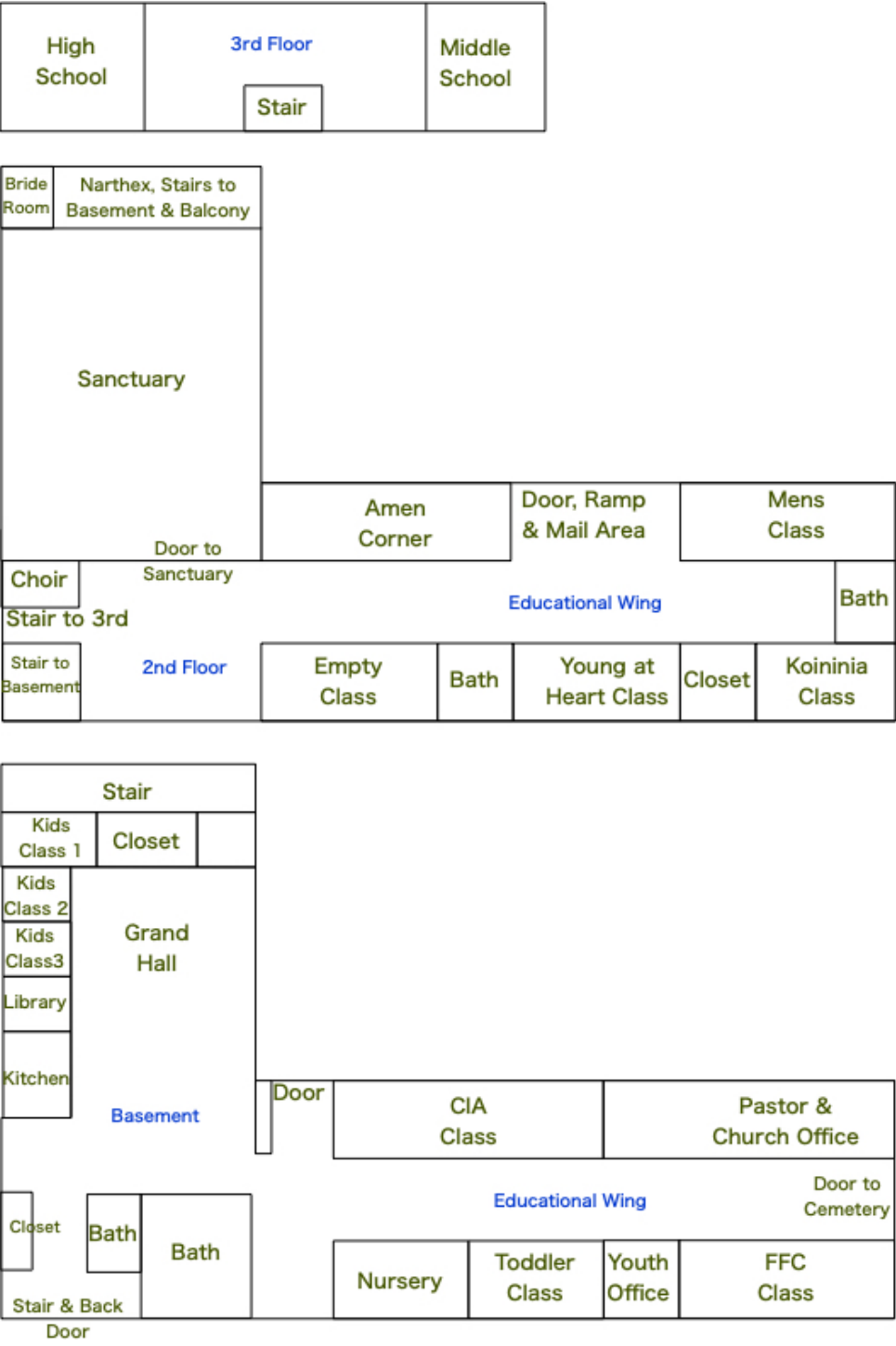
Teachers rotate throughout the year.
