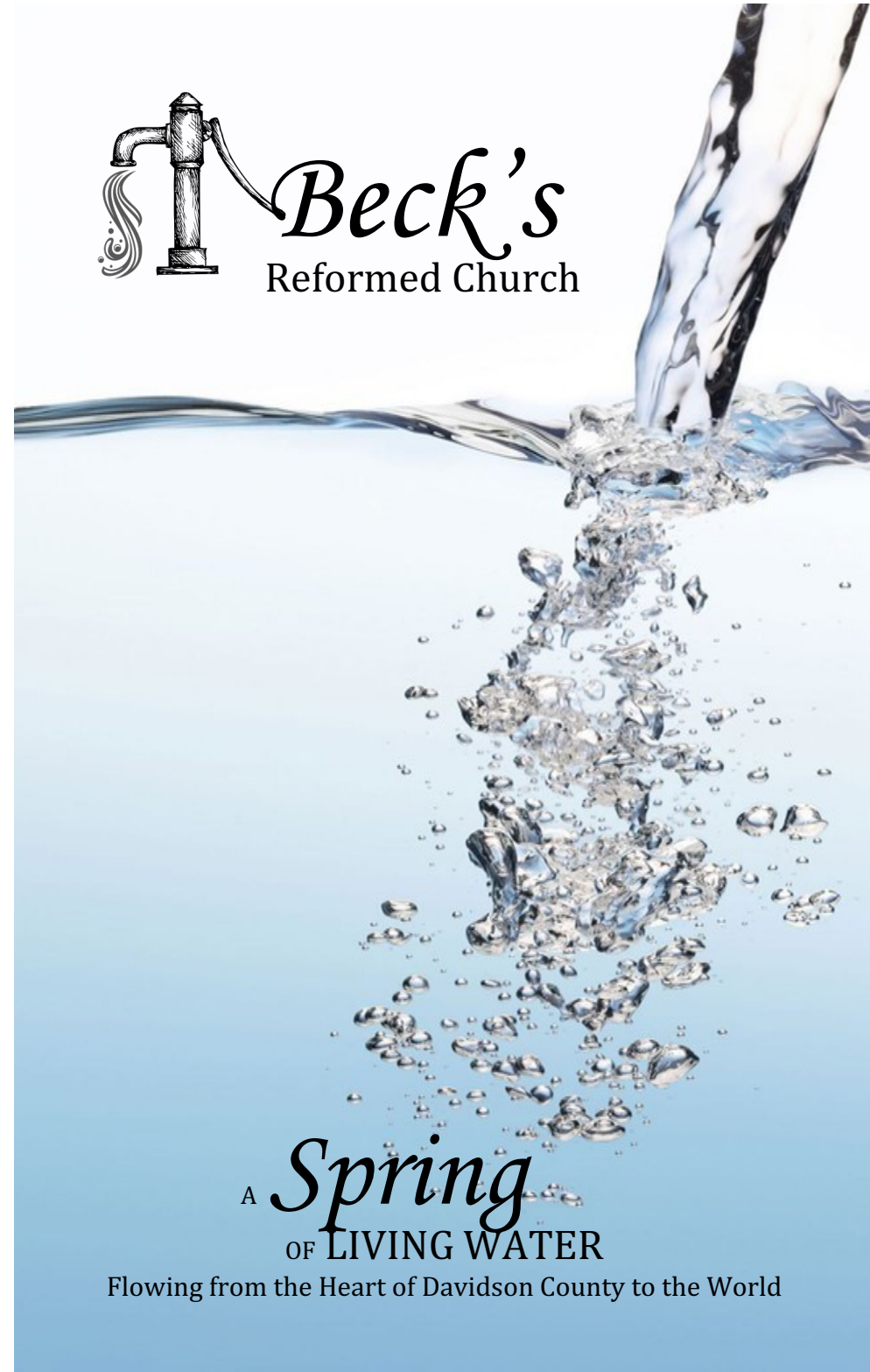

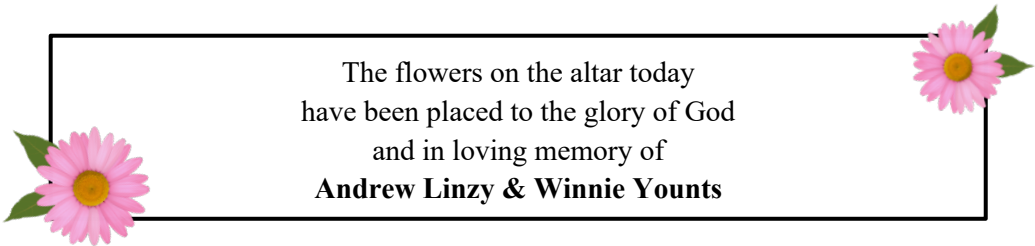

## CRAFT FAIR

Church, I know it's still August and the kids are gearing up for another great year of school, but time is fast approaching for Beck's Reformed Church CRAFT FAIR!!

The Beck's Creative Crafters and I are so excited to be hosting this fundraiser for our youth. Check this out. We have already made 500 dollars just on space rental!! The date for this event is Saturday, Oct. 14th from 8am to 3pm. The Fellowship Hall will be open on Friday the 13th for early set up from 4pm to 7pm.

In order for this event to be a success, I need the youth and as many adults (that aren't renting tables to sell their wares) to help us out.

These are areas where help will be needed:

- \* A very outgoing person sitting at a table to greet everyone and hand out stickers, crosses and pencils to all the children that come.
- \* 4 to 6 people working in the kitchen preparing the hot dog lunches as ordered. We will have eat in or take out available. Times for this is 10am to 3pm. Clean up time should take about an hour for the kitchen area. We will have 2 or 3 tables set up in front of the kitchen area for people to sit and dine in.
- \* A person sitting at a table near the kitchen to collect the money for the Hotdog Lunches. Right now the lunches will be 1 hotdog, 1 bag of chips and a canned drink or water for 5 dollars. Price might have to be adjusted once we order the supplies. Someone will need to make sure the youth's money box has change in it. Lot's of fives, tens, ones and quarters.
- \* A person to be at the Baked Goods table to collect money and watch over the food. We are also collecting baskets to have at the Baked Goods Table for people to use to shop and take their goods home in. So ladies this is a perfect opportunity to get rid of some baskets.
- \* A person to be behind the Youth tables to collect money. (These are going to be the tables next to the Baked Goods that the crafters have donated items for the youth to sell.)
- \* A person or two to help people carry all the wonderful things they buy out to their cars.
- \* 2 or 3 people to help with clean up after 3pm when the Fair is over.

It' is going to take our whole village (church) to make this event a success. It's a chance for our community come and visit our church and see Jesus in us and just maybe get some new Members and some more Souls Saved. How Awesome would that be?!!
