

Peter said to Jesus, Even if everyone should deserts you, I never will. Jesus responded to Peter, I tell you the truth, Peter—this very night, before the rooster crows twice, you will deny me three times that you even know Me. No! Peter said emphatically. Even if I have to die with You, I will never deny You!" Mark 14:29-31

Meanwhile, Peter was in the courtyard below. One of the servant girls who worked for the high priest came by and noticed Peter warming himself at the fire.
