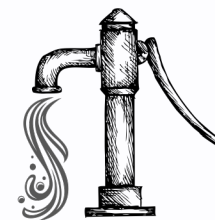

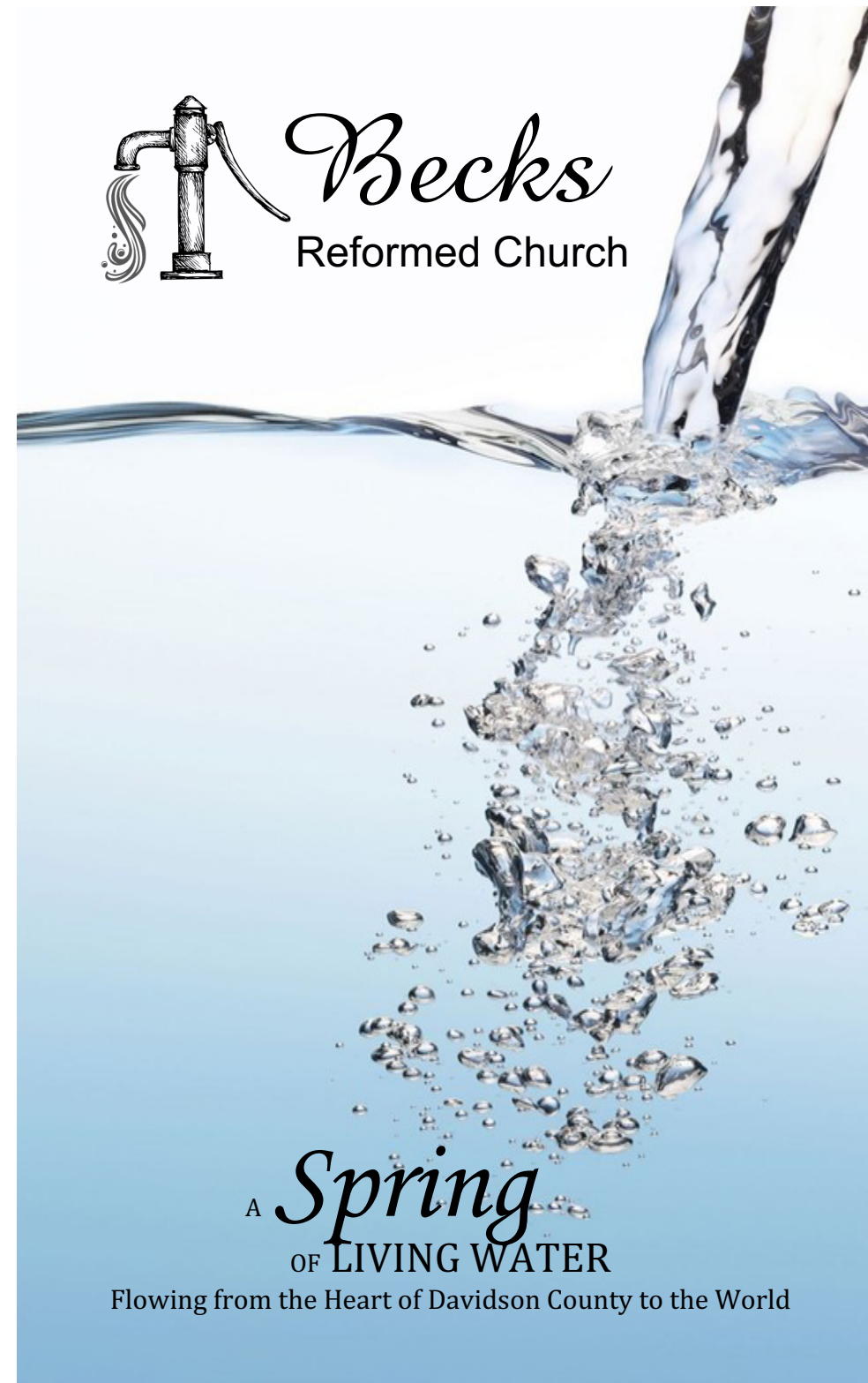

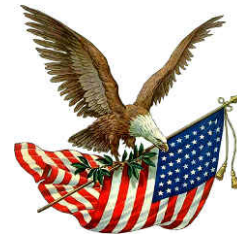

1. Look at the _____ of Christ

So, they asked Pilate to hasten their deaths by ordering that their legs be broken. The soldiers came and broke the legs of the two men crucified with Jesus.
