



Communion Schedule


We will be celebrating the Lord’s Supper this Sunday. The Consistory with Pastor Roland has decided to offer communion on the first Sunday of the month. Also, we will be observing communion through what is called, “intinction.” Intinction simply means, “dip.” What we will be asking you to do this Sunday is to come forward to receive the bread and cup. You will tear off a piece of bread and dip into the cup and then return to your seat. For those who do not wish to observe communion in this way, there will be the option of receiving communion at a station that has the bread and cup set aside. For those who are unable to come forward, there will be attendants who will bring the bread and cup to you.

The Lord’s Supper is a powerful time for us to draw together through the bread and cup. The visible signs of God’s invisible grace.
