

Relationship Goals: Dealing with Difficult Family

1. Jesus Had a		
Jesus is just the carpenter, the Son of Mary and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon. And His sisters are here with us. Matthew 13:55-56		
2. Jesus Had a Family		
Isn't this the carpenter? Matthew 6:3		
They forced Jesus out of town and took Him to the edge of the cliff on which the town was built. They planned to throw Him off the edge, but Jesus walked through the crowd and went on His way. Luke 4:29-30		
A prophet is honored everywhere except in His hometown and with His own people and in His own home. Mark 6:4		
His family went to get Him because they thought He was out of His mind. Mark 3:21		
So, Jesus' brothers said to Him, 'You should leave here and go to Judea so Your followers there can see the miracles you do. Anyone who wants to be well known does not hide what He does.
