

Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. Matthew 6:12

1. God Forgives the _____

'Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?' 'No, not seven times,' Jesus replied, 'but seventy times seven!' Matthew 18:21-22
