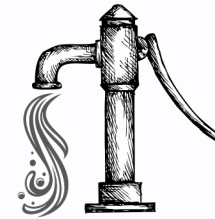

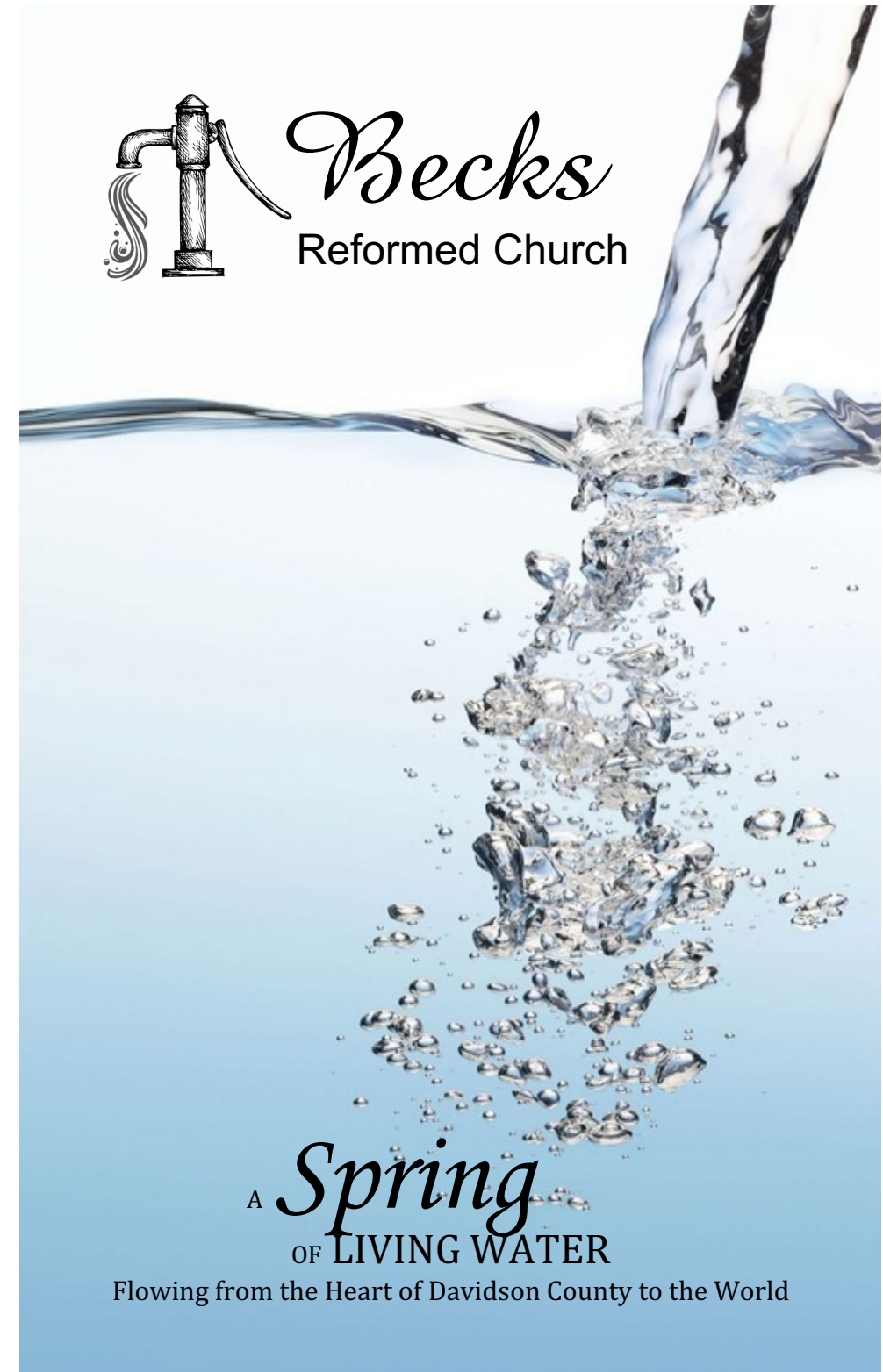

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23

## 2. God's \_\_\_\_\_

This sacrifice shows that God was being just when He did not punish those who sinned in times past, He was looking ahead and included them in what He would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate His righteousness,
