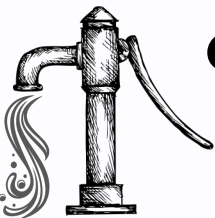

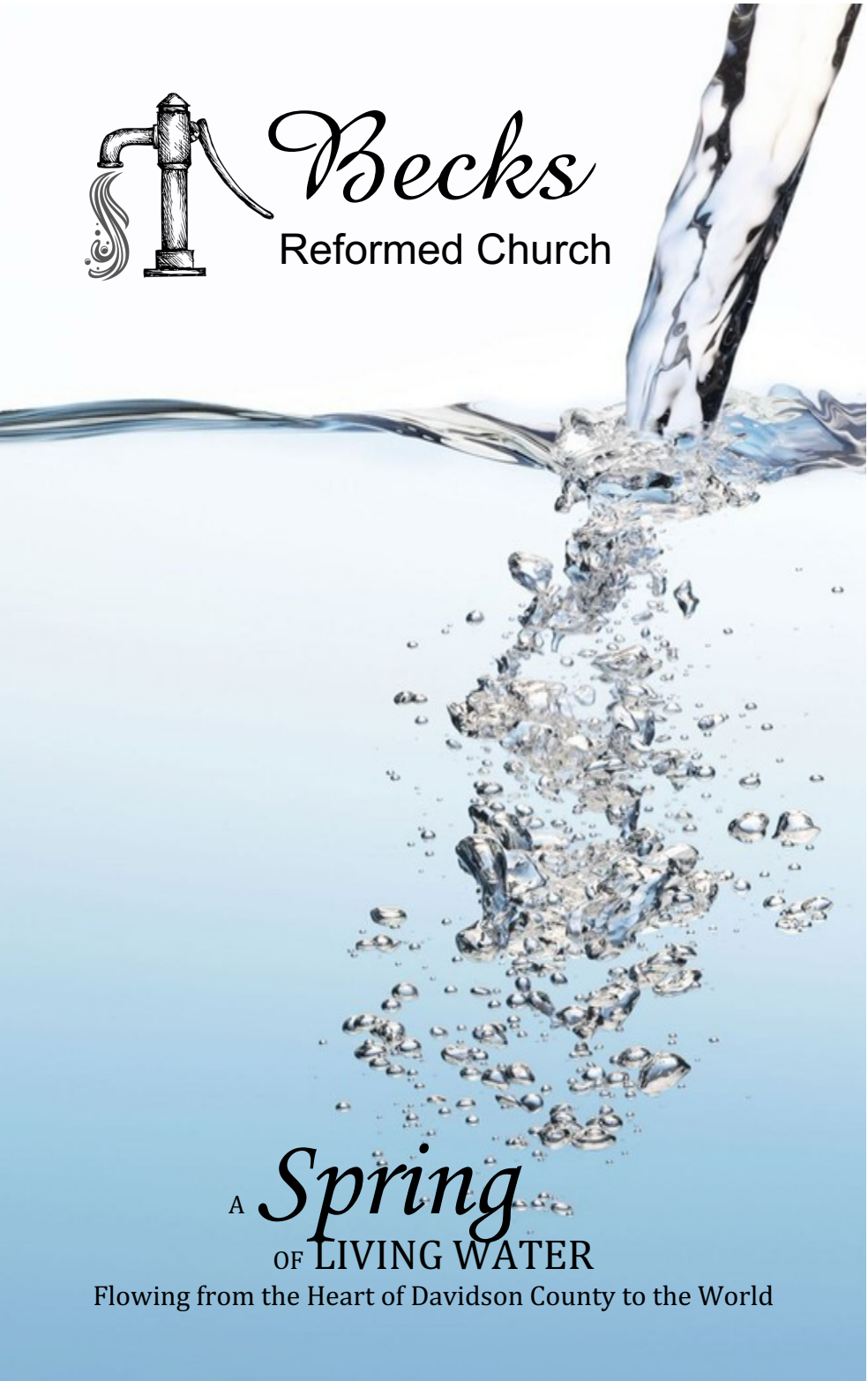

What We Believe: The Church
