The Church on Fire: The Spirit as Breath

The Spirit gives life.

John 6:63

1. The Holy Spirit _____ What is Dead

Son of man, these bones represent the people of Israel. They are saying, ‘We have become old, dry bones, all hope is gone. Our nation is finished.’
Ezekiel 37:11

Beside the rivers of Babylon, we sat and wept as we thought of Jerusalem. We put away our harps, hanging them on the branches of poplar trees. For our captors demanded a song from us. But how can we sing the songs of the Lord while in a pagan land?
Psalm 137:1–4

For I will gather you up from all the nations and bring you home again to your land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart. And I will put My Spirit in you so that you will follow My decrees. You will be My people, and I will be your God.
Ezekiel 36:24–28

The Lord took hold of me, and I was carried away by the Spirit of the Lord to a valley filled with bones. He led me all around among the bones that covered the valley floor. They were scattered everywhere across the ground and were completely dried out. 2. The Holy Spirit _____ What is Broken

Then He said to me, ‘Speak a prophetic message to these bones and say, Dry bones, listen to the word of the Lord! This is what the Sovereign Lord says, Look! I am going to put breath into you and make you live again! I will put flesh and muscles on you and cover you with skin. I will put breath

into you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I am the Lord.
Ezekiel 37:4–6

So, I spoke this message, just as He told me. Suddenly as I spoke, there was a rattling noise all across the valley. The bones of each body came together and attached themselves as complete skeletons. Then as I watched, muscles and flesh formed over the bones. Then skin formed to cover their bodies.

3. The Holy Spirit _____ What is Hopeless

Then He said to me, ‘Speak a prophetic message to the winds, son of man. Speak a prophetic message and say, This is what the Sovereign Lord says, Come, Oh breath, from the four winds! Breathe into these dead bodies so they may live again.’ So, I spoke the message as He commanded me, and breath came into their bodies. They all came to life and stood up on their feet—a great army.
