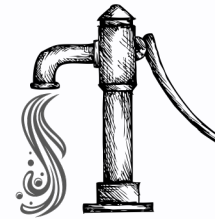

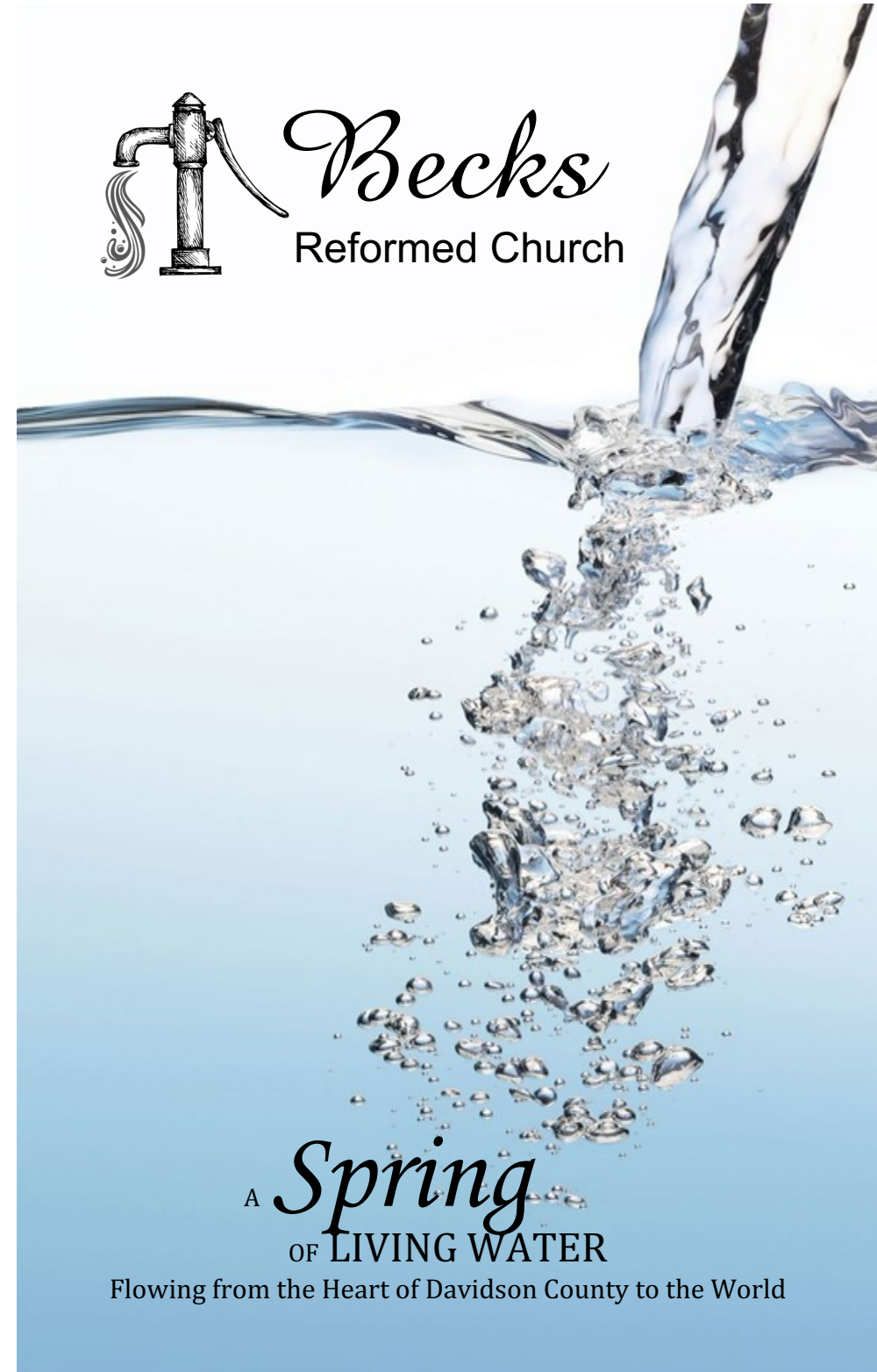

## **The Church on Fire: The Holy Spirit as Intercessor**
